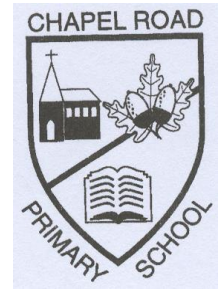

THE CURRICULUM

Chapel Road Primary School continues to provide a broad and balanced curriculum as detailed in the Northern Ireland Curriculum. As well as the core areas of learning the focus for all our teaching is on the development of skills and level of understanding. We assess pupils' progress in Communication, Using Mathematics and Using ICT.

Our Health Education programme continues to encourage children to bring healthy 'breaks' to school and emphasises the importance of eating fruit and drinking milk and water through our Healthy Eating Policy and Munch Box Challenge in P3.

Daily procedures and policies are reviewed and updated where necessary to reflect best practice. Staff are currently working together to produce a new School Development Plan for 2016-2019.

CHILD PROTECTION

Miss Kerr is the Designated Teacher for Child Protection and Mrs Conaghan is the Deputy Designated Teacher for Child Protection. All staff received updated Child Protection training in August 2016.

Our Child Protection Policy is available to view on our school website and is circulated to all new parents annually. It is also available in paper copy upon request. Child Protection procedures continue to be fully implemented in line with the Education Authority's guidelines.

PROVISION FOR PUPILS WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL or ADDITIONAL NEEDS

Mrs Bacheta is the Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator (SENCO). Mrs Bacheta's role is to lead and liaise with staff, parents and outside agencies in identifying children who have an additional educational need. The needs of the pupils are paramount and a range of support is provided by the class teacher, classroom assistants and where necessary outside agencies. The school also follows the Education Authority's referral system to access advice from the Educational Psychology Department.

Children's progress is regularly monitored and evaluated. Data is analysed and appropriate targets are set. The staff are committed to providing all pupils with the best possible education, catering for the needs of every child and ensuring all children reach their full potential.

The school works with an Education Authority Educational Psychologist and has access to advisory support and intervention when deemed necessary from other agencies such as

- Western Trust Team
- Social, Emotional and Behavioural Support Team
- Children and Mental Health Service
- Action for Children
- Speech and Language Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Autistic Spectrum Advisory Service

All pupils with an identified additional need (academic or behavioural) have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) which is constructed and reviewed on a termly basis in consultation with the class teacher, pupil and his/her parents/guardians.

EXTENDED SCHOOL FACILITY-EARLY YEARS

The school was once again in receipt of additional monies through Extended Schools funding. We have used this funding, as in previous years, to facilitate an extended day for our early year's pupils. The aim is to target Literacy and Numeracy skills through a 'Learning through Play' approach. The children benefit from developing social skills and language through exploring and investigating a range of play scenarios.

In a recent survey sent out to parents, the feedback received was 100% positive highlighting the excellent experiences of the children and also the high quality relationships and professionalism of the staff involved. This Extended School funding has been decreasing annually and as a result the provision is under review to reflect the reduction in available funds.

KEY STAGE ASSESSMENT OUTCOMES

Due to on-going industrial action, we are unable to publish End-of-Key-Stage assessment result for this period. The majority of NI primary schools have now refrained from engaging in this process due to concerns over the educational validity of the system.

Parents can be assured that our internal assessment and reporting systems are as robust as ever, and that every child continues to have the opportunity to reach their full academic potential. You can make an appointment with the class teacher or the principal if you wish to discuss your child's progress.

SAFEGUARDING-SECURITY

To safeguard staff and pupils all visitors must report to the school office and sign in and out. Gates to the school must be kept closed during the day and entry to the school premises is via a buzzer system. All unexpected visitors are challenged.

CCTV security is in operation 24 hours a day and the school regularly liaises with our security provider, local community police and health and safety department (Education Authority) who provide advice on how to maintain the highest safety standards to ensure the safety of the children, staff and premises.

SCHOOL FINANCE

School bank accounts are monitored by the Finance Committee (SUB) of the school's Board of Governors, reconciled by the school's secretary and signed off annually by the Chair of Governors. Income derives from contributions and fund-raising initiatives.

An internal audit of all school accounts, procedures and policies was completed in May 2016 by the Education Authority Audit Office. All recommendations from this report have been raised and actions put in place to fulfil all statutory requirements. The Financial Report presented below refers to the money held in the school fund account.
