## Homework

It is important that your child has a quiet place to complete their homework away from all distractions.

Please check their work, ensuring it is accurate and presented neatly.

P6 Children will have:

Reading homework every night - Monday — Thursday

Spelling homework every night - Monday - Thursday

Two Mental Arithmetic (M.A) homework's per week - Monday and Wednesday

Two Literacy homework's per week -Tuesday and Thursday

**Mathletics** — 10mins every night- tasks will be assigned weekly to your child based on their ability level.

I will print out your child's Mathletics certificates and display them for the month in our classroom. I will take a photograph of the children who have received their certificates and put it on the website at the end of the month and then children can take them home.

On a Friday we will complete a 'Show me what you know' activity which will consist of 10 out of the 20 spellings of the week chosen by me at random. I will also choose 10 numeracy questions based on what we have been learning about in school that week.
