Dear families and friends

REMINDER SCHOOL CLOSURES

- 1. School is closed on Monday 29th November 2021. We return on Tuesday 30th November.
- 2. School will close for our Christmas holidays on Wednesday 22nd December 2021 at 12 noon. Children return to school on Wednesday 5th January 2022.

COVID UPDATE

Unfortunately, similar to other schools and the local community, we are experiencing a rise in covid cases within our school. This is disappointing as we were doing so well. There is no doubt that the virus is more easily spread and can go undetected for a few/number of days which means more people are becoming infected.

I am confident that this will pass and we send our good wishes to anyone who is sick or unwell. We have received calls in relation to vulnerable family and staff members in our school community. Please help us to protect everyone by observing COVID advice and guidelines.

Remain vigilant for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.

Do not send your child to school if they have COVID symptoms such as:

- · a high temperature
- \cdot a new continuous cough
- \cdot loss of or change to their sense of taste or smell

We will contact you if your child becomes sick during the school day.

If your child has COVID-19 symptoms:

Book your child a PCR test as soon as possible.

He/she should isolate until you get the result. If it is negative he/she can carry on as normal and return to school as long as they are well (no fever for 48 hours).

If it is positive he/she should isolate for 10 days. You will receive further information by text message and a contact tracing call from the PHA.

You should advise us that your child has tested positive.

ADVERSE WEATHER/ SNOW ARRANGEMENTS

Luckily, we do not experience too many days where we feel that we may not be able to open the school or that weather conditions may hinder attendance at school. To put it into context, children are expected to attend 185 school days so we are only talking about a very small number of adverse weather days when conditions may cause us an issue. We try not to dwell on these days but focus on all the other happy days we come to school.

In the event of adverse weather conditions, the most important factor is the Health & Safety of every member of our school community.

To ensure you do not feel under pressure or put anyone in a situation where children or adults are at risk we would encourage you to carefully assess the weather conditions before making the journey to school. We understand that a large number of families including staff live in areas where there are steep hills and untreated roads. We do not want anyone to worry about the journey to school. We also understand that parents and guardians have the added pressure of needing to get to work on time. Unfortunately, we cannot predict or change bad weather but we can offer solutions to help us have a more pleasant experience.

Please note the following:

As far as is possible we will always try to open the school, however, on the rare occasion where it is deemed too dangerous, a message will be sent through the website and on Facebook at the earliest opportunity.

In the event of adverse weather, there is no immediate rush required to get to school. Children will be marked in for the morning session if they arrive in before 10.30am. Just contact the office to let us know.

If you can avoid driving up the hill to the school, please do so as it can be very slippy, especially around school time when traffic is going in both directions. A later arrival will also mean you will miss some of the congestion. A number of parents used the entrance down at Shepherd's Glen last year and they found this an easier route.

Just an additional note on the above: I have tried to get the 'gritter' to come up and salt the hill and have been told that we need to have a larger number of road users to justify this. If you have time, I would encourage you to continue to put pressure on the local MLAs and council to afford us this much needed service.
